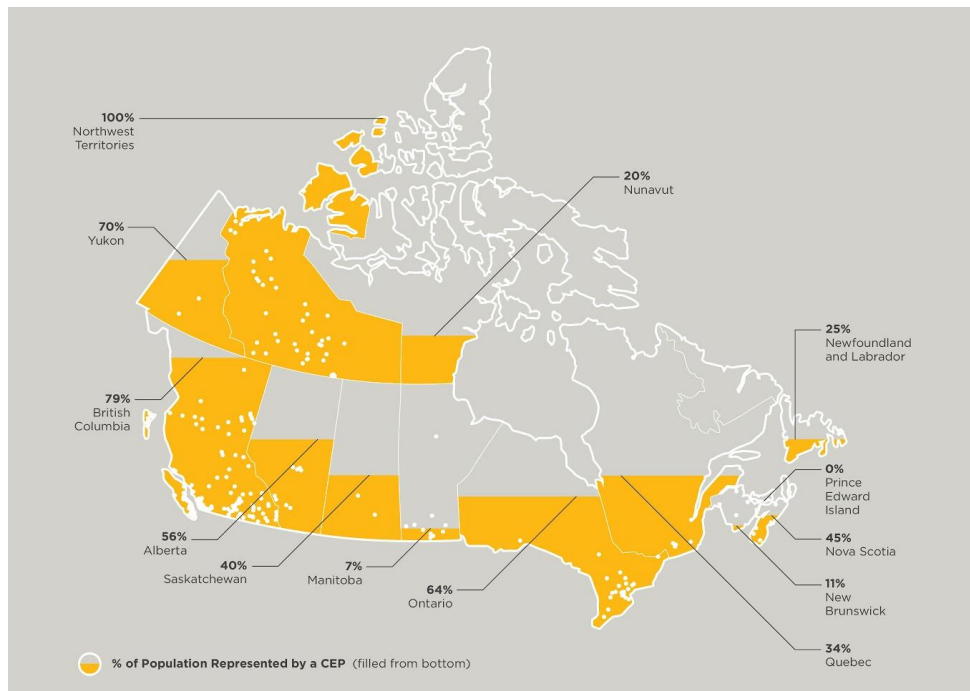

5-fold increase expected in Ontario

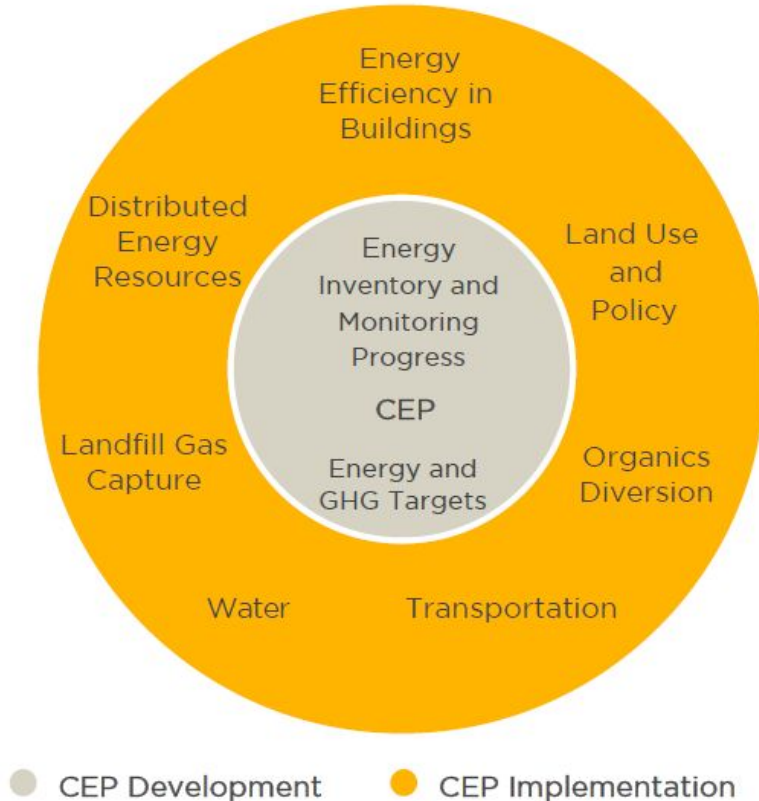
# WHAT IS A COMMUNITY ENERGY PLAN



Community energy planning defines community priorities around energy with a view to shape how energy is generated, delivered and used, now and into the future.

- Cut GHG emissions

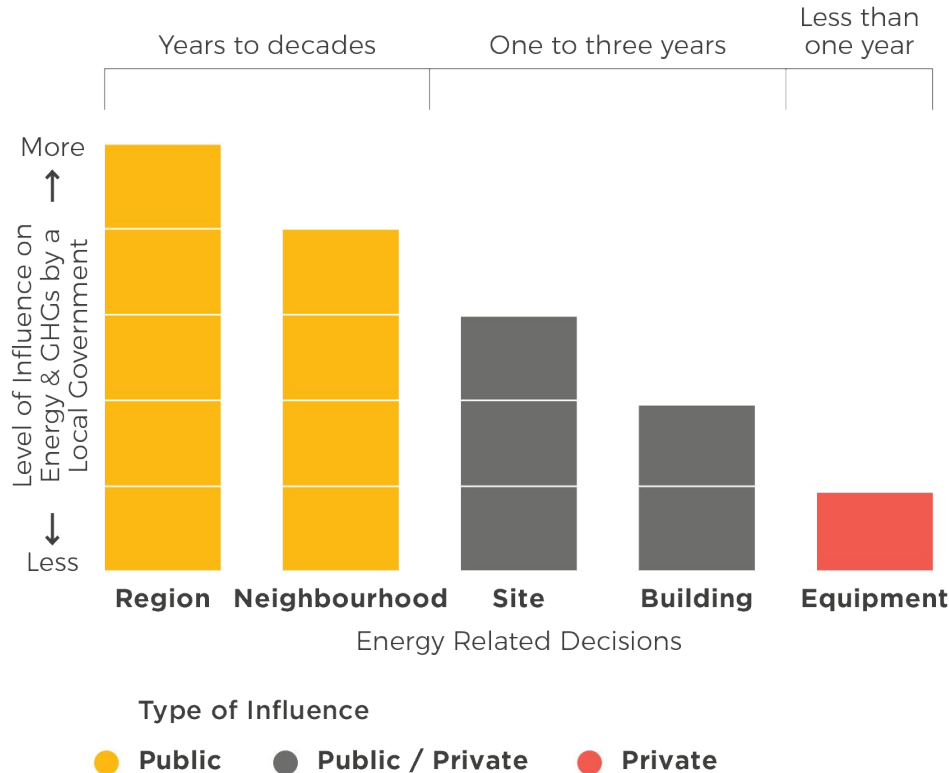
# WHAT IS A COMMUNITY ENERGY PLAN
